Rancho Salina Vineyards Moon Mountain District, Sonoma County

VINEYARD

Rancho Salina is a hillside vineyard estate located two miles north of the historic Sonoma plaza, on the western slopes of the Mayacamas mountain range at an elevation of 800+ feet above sea level. Grape grower Joe Votek and owner Dom Paino have combined their own talents to produce these ultra-premium quality grapes which make up this deliciously, outstanding wine.

VINTAGE

66% Merlot and 34% Cabernet Sauvignon, all from the Rancho Salina Vineyard Estate.

TASTING NOTES

This sophisticated wine features captivating aromas of wild berries, fresh herbs, allspice, toffee, vanilla, and cedar. On the palate, the flavors are layered with deep notes of sweet cherry, black raspberry, red currant, cranberry, bittersweet chocolate, savory spices, and roasted walnuts. This is a splendid example of pure mountain fruit captured inside the bottle. In the end, this is a fabulous wine to serve with hard cheeses, roasted mushrooms, hearty Italian dishes, pork tenderloin, seared duck breast, grilled steaks, rack of lamb, and fine Asian cuisine.
