Wine: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon
AVA: Napa Valley

Notes: Sustainably farmed, the vineyards consist of gravelly fast draining soils which make way for a wine with depth and layers. Organically made and aged in 30% new oak barrels, this 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon displays concentrated black fruit with savory notes of mint, dried herbs, cedar, spice, and fresh tilled earth.

80% of the grapes were grown on the valley floor of the Oakville appellation and 20% grown in the higher elevated vineyard of Mt. Veeder.
