


2007 Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley

Tasting Notes: This wine has a traditional Bordeaux color and aromas of dark chocolate and pepper. Flavors of plums and black cherries linger as you finish with hints toasted vanilla. The tannins are soft and acidity is balanced in this very smooth and delicious Cabernet.

Production Notes

The 2007 growing season started with a fairly dry winter followed by summer temperatures that ranged from mild to cool, with very few days topping 100 degrees. In the vineyard, the vines produced an above average cluster count, but the berry and cluster size were smaller which results an intensely flavored fruit harvest. The grapes were picked and crushed in October 2007. The juice was pumped over twice a day until fermentation was complete. The wine was racked to a mixture of neutral and French Oak Barrels. In June 2009 the wine was bottled with a total production of 200 cases.
