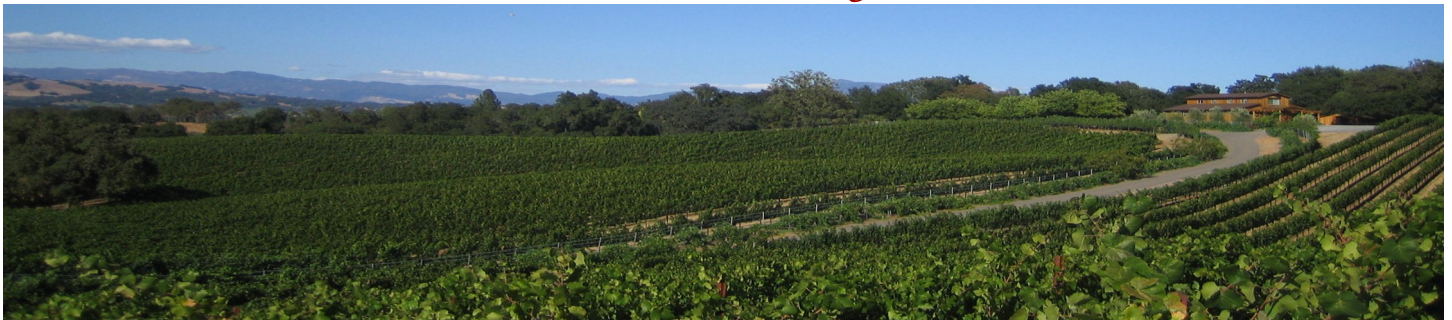




2009 Russian River Valley Pinot Noir



The Vineyard

Our 2009 Russian River Valley Pinot Noir was produced from premium vineyards in the Russian River Valley and harvested in early September.

Winemaking

After a five day cold soak and an eight day fermentation, the wine was stored in 60% new/ 40% neutral French oak barrels, going through malo-lactic fermentation and stored for fourteen months. The wine was bottled and set aside for further aging before its release.
