The vineyard is a mix of Dijon, and clone 23. The hilltop vineyard receives 180-degree sun, and much warmer days than what we are used to in Russian River, with much more intense winds in the afternoon. This combination of sun, heat and wind puts a very different type of stress on the vine and produces a much richer, fuller bodied Pinot Noir.

2009 was a long mild growing season with a particularly late harvest. September started off with a ten day long heat spell followed by a cool 3 to 4 weeks. This gave the nearly fully ripened fruit extra hang time to develop additional flavor. The vineyard had a maximum time to develop intense flavors and aromas. The vineyard is noted for a round rich texture with intense aromas of red raspberries, brown spices and long rich finish. The wine is enjoyable now but has the body and flavor intensity to age for an additional five years. An ideal wine with Game, Duck and more seasoned chicken dishes.

2009 Kaufman Sunnyslope Vineyard Pinot Noir vineyard is located in the western corner of the Sonoma Mountain between the Silver Pines and Van der Kamp vineyards. The vineyard is planted with approximately seven acres of premium Pinot Noir clones.



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
