*Rancho Salina is a hillside winegrape growing estate located two miles north of historic Sonoma Plaza, on the western slopes of the Mayacamas Range at an elevation of 800+ feet above sea level. Grape grower Joe Votek and investor Dom Paino have combined their own talents to produce these premium quality grapes which make up this outstanding wine.*

VINTAGE

*2012 vintage was a changing year weather wise. We worked overtime in the vineyards and it show in the quality of the grapes.*

TASTING NOTES

*This is a full-bodied wine with generous aromas of dark berry, leather, tea leaf, tobacco, cedar and vanilla. Elegant flavors of blackberry, raspberry, boysenberry, red currant and plum create subtle nuances. Bittersweet chocolate, rosemary, licorice and roasted black walnuts make a soft, elegant and engaging wine. This is a splendid example of pure mountain fruit captured inside the bottle. Fabulous pairings include aged gouda and hard cheeses, risotto with wild mushrooms, red meats, pork tenderloin and roasted duck.*
