


2006 Cabernet Sauvignon Crane Ranch Vineyard Hillside Block Napa Valley

Crane Brothers Napa Valley Wines are all estate grown, single vineyard, and very small production from the family owned Crane Ranch Vineyard. Third generation Napa Valley natives Michael and Robert Crane and winemaker Al Perry have made great wines together since the 2001 vintage. Located in The Oak Knoll District of the Napa Valley, the 9 acre Crane Ranch Vineyard is planted on bench land and hillside, above the valley floor. The unique microclimate of warm sunny days and cool breezy evenings, along with our custom hand farming, allow our Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Petit Verdot grapes to develop intense flavor, color, and aroma.

Tasting Notes:

Luscious aromas of blackberry pie, black raspberry, mocha and cigar box. The rich middle is a rich mix of black currants, black tea, sweet tannins and sweet oak. A beautiful balance between structure and power.

The wine is 100% estate grown at our family owned Crane Ranch Vineyard in the Oak Knoll District of Napa Valley which is managed by John Anthony Truchard's Vinewerkes custom farming company.
